The Touch of Jesus

2. Matthew 8:14 - Jesus touches Peter's mother-in-law
3. Matthew 17:7 - Jesus touches fear filled disciples
4. Mark 7:31 - Jesus touches a deaf man
5. Mark 10:13 - Jesus touches the children
6. Luke 7:14 -Jesus touches a casket
7. Luke 22:51 -Jesus touches a soldier

Consider and Discuss

- Discuss the rejection and isolation the Leper must have felt in his life. What do you think it feels like to be "untouchable".
- Have you ever experienced something painful in your life that caused you to wonder if God had cursed you, or was punishing you? How did you overcome that wrong thinking? Discuss with the group the importance of the touch of Jesus that reassures us of His grace and love in overcoming wrong thinking about how Jesus feels about us.
- Use these scriptures to help in discussion: Romans 5:8, Romans 8:35-39
- Choose one of the "touches of Jesus" that you related to and discuss with the group how that has made your relationship with Jesus even closer.
- Was there a "touch of Jesus" that you related to by realizing you need and want that specific touch? Why not ask your group for prayer and believe that Jesus is in the room right now ready to respond to your request.
